Lecture on own works by **Paolo Cavinato**, artist (IT)

Paolo Cavinato presents his work, with perspectivating examples from Italian art.

Through a variety of expressive techniques, Paolo Cavinato creates multisensory spaces in which images of reality converge as rational constructions and emotive projections.

His research starts from physical space, arriving at an abstract space: a journey, where the viewer is personally involved in the works.

Paolo Cavinato is an Italian artist, based in Mantua in Northern Italy.

He is currently undertaking a residency in Copenhagen, invited by the exhibition space Sydhavn Station, where he is creating a site specific installation for the exhibition "Travel". The installation contains an infinite, dreamlike passage and suggests the possibility of being dissolved or disappeared, like the ambiguous potential of a journey: You can be a new person - or be lost.
